The following summarizes the educational programming offered by Student Affairs. In 2005-06, revisions were made to the Educational Programming Record (EPR) corresponding with the initiatives related to purposeful education such as the cataloging of ongoing workshops and presentations, defining learning outcomes, developing online learning opportunities, and creating certificates.

**Programs and Attendance**

In total, **2,894** Student Affairs educational programs were entered online for the 2005-06 academic year with an estimated attendance of **99,818**.

**Program Type**

One of the additions to the 2005-06 EPR was recording the program type. With this information, we can provide a more accurate view of the division-wide programming efforts and changes in our programs from year to year.

**Primary Audience**

Of the programs entered, students were the primary audience for 2,746 programs. Of these programs, 141 were classroom presentations and 708 targeted first-year students.
